CURRICULUM DEVELOPMENT

The Board of Education recognizes its responsibility for the quality of the educational program of the schools. To this end, the curriculum shall be developed, evaluated, and adopted on a continuing basis and in accordance with Board approved Academic Standards as required by Section 118.30 (1g) (a) of the Statutes.

For purposes of this policy and consistent communication throughout the District, curriculum shall be defined as the courses of study, subjects, classes, and organized activities provided by the school to accomplish the educational goals of the School District.

The Board directs that the curriculum of this District:

- A. complies with adopted Academic Standards of the School District. The adopted Academic Standards shall be the basis for instructional programming decisions.
- B. provides instruction in courses consistent with statute and regulations of the Department of Public Instruction or appropriate State agency;
- C. allows for the development of individual talents and interests as well as recognizes that learning styles and abilities of students may differ.

The Superintendent/designee shall be responsible to the Board for the development and evaluation of curriculum and the preparation of courses of study.

The Superintendent/designee shall make progress reports to the Board annually.
