### ADOPTION OF COURSES

The Board of Education shall provide a comprehensive instructional program to serve the educational needs of the students of this District. Board approved academic standards shall be the basis for courses.

The Board shall determine which units of the instructional program constitute courses and are subject to the adoption procedures of the Board. No course shall be taught in the schools of this District unless it has been adopted by the Board.

The Superintendent/designee shall recommend to the Board such courses of study as are deemed to be in the best interests of the students and are needed to comply with State law and Board approved academic standards.

The Board of Education has adopted Academic Standards as required by Section 118.30 (1g) (a) of the Statutes. The Academic Standards should be the basis for instructional programming decisions.
