### YOUTH OPTIONS PROGRAM

The Board will allow high school juniors and seniors who meet the criteria to enroll in approved postsecondary programs while in attendance in the District. Students will be eligible to receive either college or high school credit for completing any of these programs providing they meet the established requirements. Senior students are eligible for participation in the youth options program for no more than two consecutive semesters after acquiring senior status.

Guidelines should ensure that such programs are in accord with State regulations and are properly communicated by October 1 of each school year to both the students in grades 9-11 and their parents. The guidelines and procedures shall be established for the awarding of credit and the proper entry on a student's transcript and other records of his/her participation in a postsecondary program.

The Columbus School District shall ensure that students and parents are informed of the State Youth Options Program. Guidelines will establish criteria for reasons for not allowing a student to participate in the program.

Tuition and fees shall be made in accordance with the formulas established in 118.55 Wis. Stats.
