### CHILDREN AT RISK OF NOT GRADUATING FROM HIGH SCHOOL

The Columbus School District recognizes the importance of providing educational opportunities in support of all students including those determined to be "at risk". It shall be the District's responsibility to:

- A. identify students at risk of not graduating from high school according to current state statutes.
- B. evaluate the student's educational needs.
- C. develop and implement appropriate educational services that will allow students to progress sufficiently to graduate from high school or to such a level that they are no longer considered at risk.\_
- D. when appropriate, collaborate with community agencies to identify barriers to school participation and plan comprehensive services to meet student needs.
