ELECTRONIC DEVICES/BEEPERS

Student use or possession of electronic paging or two-way communication devices (e.g., beepers) and laser pointers on school premises (owned, rented by, or under control of the school) is prohibited. Any student found violating this policy shall be disciplined accordingly. Violations may result in confiscation of the devices and disciplinary action, including possible suspension.

This policy will be published in student handbooks and distributed annually.

The building principal, however, is authorized to permit a student to use and/or carry a “beeper” for medical, school, educational, vocational or other purposes as deemed appropriate. Students who have a legitimate reason to use or carry a beeper at school should request prior permission to do so from the building principal.

Whenever this policy is revised by the Board, the Superintendent shall submit a copy of such policy to the State Superintendent of Public Instruction.
