THE SCHOOLS AND GOVERNMENTAL AGENCIES

The Board of Education is committed to protect students from individuals not associated with the school system but also recognizes its responsibility to cooperate with law enforcement agencies and the Department of Social Services.

When such agencies request permission to interrogate a student at school, the principal shall ensure that the agency has informed or will inform the parents, when appropriate.

When an agency requests permission to remove a student, the principal shall notify the District Administrator.

No student shall be released to an agency, other than law enforcement or child protection agency, without proper warrant or written parental permission, except in the event of emergency or for the protection of life or property as determined by the principal, or any other reasons outlined in state law for release of students to such agencies.
