STUDENT INTERVIEWS BY LAW ENFORCEMENT

The School District of Columbus recognizes that cooperation with law enforcement agencies is necessary for the education and protection of the students, for maintaining a safe school environment and for safeguarding all school property. At the same time, the District recognizes the need to minimize disruptions in the educational process and to provide for concerns of parents/guardians regarding the welfare of their children.

It is desirable that police interviews of students take place away from the school setting, and every attempt will be made to do so. However, both the school and law enforcement agencies recognize that it is not always possible to carry out these responsibilities in such a manner. When it is necessary for students to be interviewed in the school setting, school officials and law enforcement officers shall abide by established administrative guidelines.
