### STUDENT DISCIPLINE

Without good discipline the school cannot discharge its primary responsibilities of teaching and fostering the development of citizenship; nor can the students realize their opportunities for growth.

In maintaining discipline, teachers should observe the school's policy on discipline and be able to proceed with the assurance that support will be forthcoming from the principal, District Administrator, and the School Board.

The Board of Education supports the procedures administered in each school student handbook. Student handbooks will be reviewed yearly and approved by the Board of Education.

The District shall not discriminate in standards or rules of behavior or disciplinary action, including suspension and expulsion, on the basis of sex, race, religion, national origin, color, ancestry, creed, pregnancy, marital or parental status, sexual orientation, physical, mental, emotional or learning disability or handicap. Discrimination complaints shall be processed in accordance with established procedures.
