Control of Casual-Contact Communicable Diseases

The Columbus School District, in an effort to control communicable disease, shall:

- 1) instruct staff members in the detection of these common diseases and measures for their prevention and control;
- 2) remove students from District property to the care of a responsible adult;
- 3) prepare standards for re-admission of students who have recovered from casual-contact communicable diseases*; and
- 4) file reports as required by statute and the State Department of Health.

* For the purpose of these guidelines, casual-contact communicable diseases shall include diphtheria, scarlet fever and other strep infections, whooping cough, mumps, measles, rubella, and others designated by the Wisconsin Department of Public Health.
