

# PROJECT PROGRESS REPORT



### **WHAT'S NEW?**

At the elementary school, work is transitioning from the addition to the renovation of the existing building. The newly constructed addition is being cleaned and prepared for occupancy while demolition begins in the existing building.

At the high school, construction crews are working in multiple areas of the school. New windows are being installed in the music and library area, and a fresh coat of paint has been applied. In the STEAM area, demolition is ongoing, preparing the school for a dramatic transformation.

### **CONSTRUCTION UPDATE**

### Elementary School

- » In the new addition, the gym floor has been sanded and stained. Laminate tops have been installed on the new lockers, and exterior doors have been painted.
- » Demolition in the existing building began in late May. This work included removing floor and ceiling finishes in the library and classrooms.
- » Mechanical, electrical, plumbing and structural work is taking place in the existing building to support the new improvements. Plumbing contractors are working on existing underground pipes. Existing roof joists are being reinforced to support new rooftop mechanical equipment.
- » Exterior site work is ongoing. The playground has been installed, and concrete sidewalks have been poured

#### High School.

- » The library, choir, and band rooms received a fresh coat of paint. Installation of new ceiling tile began in the library in late May.
- Demolition is ongoing in the STEAM wing. Mechanical, electrical, and plumbing work to support the new renovation is beginning.

### High School

### Elementary School

» In early June, the application of topsoil for the green space will begin. At the same time, "rough-ins" above the ceiling will begin in the existing building.
